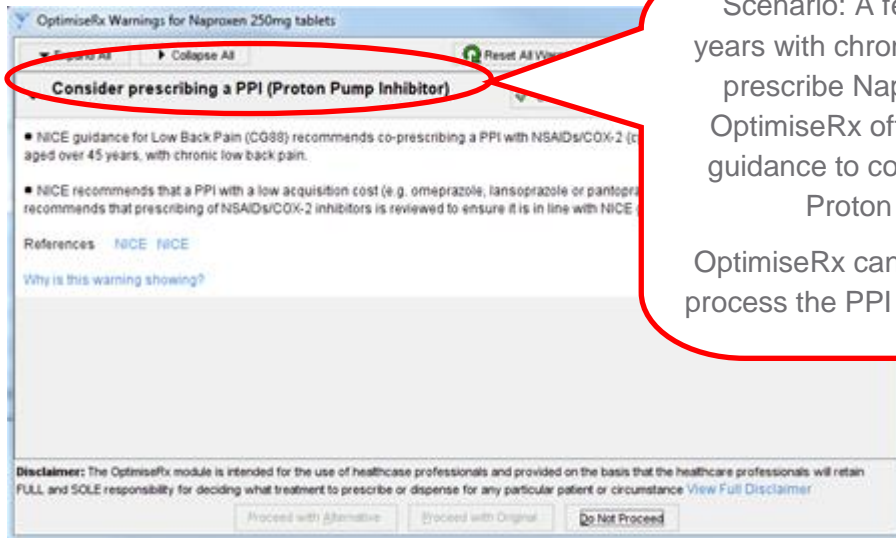


# OptimiseRx SystmOne cheatsheet – Co-Prescribe

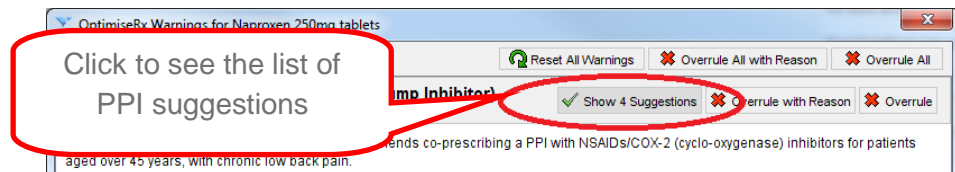
## Simplify your workflow with OptimiseRx Co-Prescribe functionality

OptimiseRx has the ability to inform you when co-prescribing opportunities could prove beneficial to your patient, and has a really neat way of helping you choose the right drug to co-prescribe, quickly and efficiently.

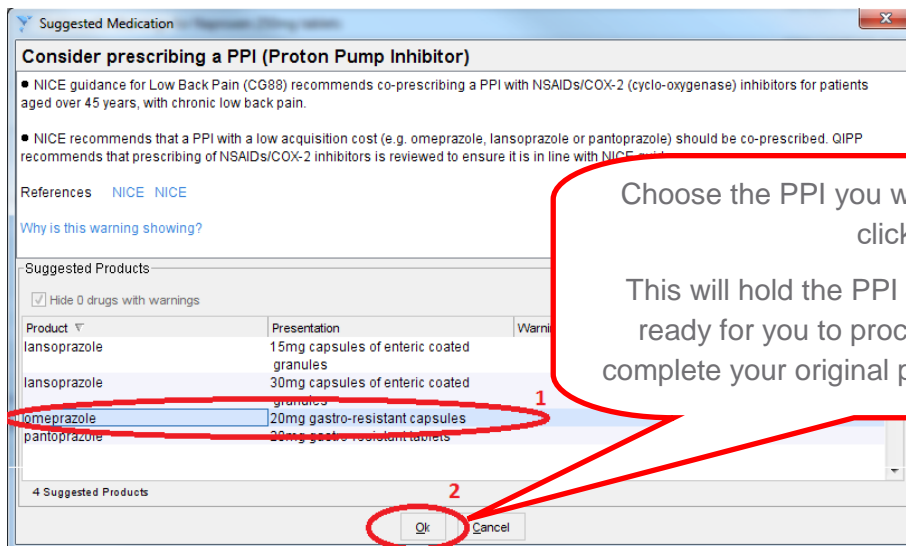


Scenario: A female patient aged 58 years with chronic lower back pain. You prescribe Naproxen 250mg tablets. OptimiseRx offers the following NICE guidance to consider co-prescribing a Proton Pump Inhibitor.

OptimiseRx can work with SystmOne to process the PPI prescription, here's how:

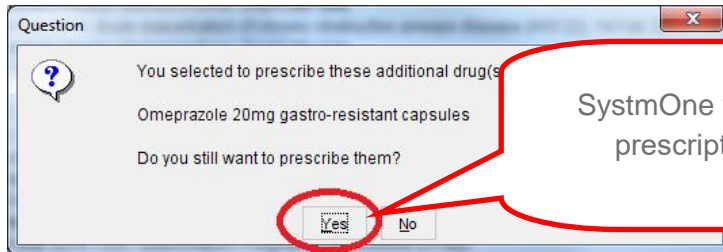
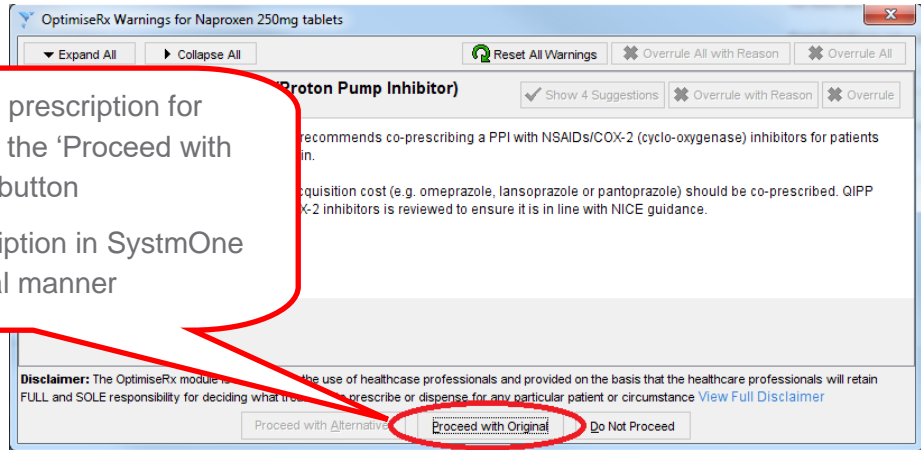


Choose the PPI you wish to co-prescribe and click 'Ok'

This will hold the PPI prescription in a queue ready for you to process, and return you to complete your original prescription for Naproxen

Continue with your prescription for Naproxen by clicking the 'Proceed with Original' button  
Complete your prescription in SystmOne in your usual manner



SystmOne will remind you that you have a prescription item queued. Click 'Yes'

The PPI you selected is now loaded into the SystmOne prescribing window, simply complete the prescription in your usual manner
